## Keynote Address:

### John Woodson, Director of Tri-County Media Arts Production



John W. Woodson, II has taught multimedia skill in the Media Arts Production (MAP) at Tri-County Technical College since Fall 2002. Born in Elberton, Georgia, his family moved to Anderson, where he graduated from Westside High School.

John worked in radio for over 20 years, beginning at WHPB AM, Belton. He went on to work for WWRK, Elberton, WANS AM & FM Anderson, Greenville, WLKQ-FM, Atlanta, and Classic Rock 101.1. He also taught as an adjunct at TCTC and at Forrest Junior College.

He spent most of his radio career at WRIX AM and FM, beginning as the overnight DJ. He left WRIX as the General Manager and host of The Morning Show. He was also a member of the South Carolina Broadcasters Association Board of Directors.

In 2016, he worked with the MAP Faculty to convert Radio and TV Broadcasting into Media Arts Production. The enrollment has doubled, with articulation agreements with several four-year colleges. The placement rate of MAP graduates is 75%.

He is here today because without comprehensive studies, prep classes, tutors, and patient math teachers, he would not have finished college in the first place. He understands the importance of what this organization does.
